OPPORTUNITIES IN SASKATCHEWAN

A Perfusionist is a health-care professional that primarily works with cardiac (heart) surgeons, anesthesiologists and other members of the operating room team. Their primary role is maintain a patient's respiration, circulation and physiological state, using state-of-the-art equipment like the heart-lung machine during surgery.

Perfusionists who work at the Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) work with inter-professional members of the operating room teams in Saskatoon and Regina. Perfusionists work in shifts to cover the needs of the operating room as well as emergency on call coverage.

- Cardiovascular Perfusion advanced certificate
- Successful completion of certifying exam of Canadian Society of Clinical Perfusion

A member in good standing of the Canadian Society of Clinical Perfusion (CSCP)

Other Education and Training:

Cardiovascular Perfusion diploma is acceptable

- Hiring incentive and relocation assistance of up to \$130,000 may be available based on location
