

PERFUSIONIST OPPORTUNITIES IN SASKATCHEWAN

A Perfusionist is a health-care professional that primarily works with cardiac (heart) surgeons, anesthesiologists and other members of the operating room team.

Perfusionists who work at the Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) work with interprofessional members of the operating room teams in Saskatoon and Regina. Perfusionists work in shifts to cover the needs of the operating room as well as emergency on call coverage.

Qualifications:

- · Cardiovascular Perfusion advanced certificate
- Successful completion of certifying exam of Cdn Society of Clinical Perfusion

Licenses:

• Basic Life Support Certificate (BLS)

Memberships:

• Registered/eligible for registration with the appropriate licensing body

Other Education and Training:

Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Level B Certificate (CPR)

Benefits and Incentives:

- Hiring incentive of \$100,000 may be available plus relocation up to \$3,000
- · Defined Benefit and Pension Plan
- Paid Annual Vacation
