The applicant will be responsible for the cardio-circulatory and cardio-pulmonary functions of patients using an extracorporeal circulation device during surgery or cardiac assistance to maintain physiological functions. The applicant will also be responsible for the start-up, monitoring, maintenance, transportation, withdrawal, and stopping of the circulatory devices, as well as the assembling and set up of the extracorporeal circuit. The incumbent will carry out all responsibilities related to the proper functioning of the department.

The Chicoutimi Hospital has 12 operating rooms, one of which is dedicated to cardiac surgery. You will join a team of 2 perfusionists, proactively collaborating with the various individuals in the operating room and the hemodynamics service.

Participate in responsibilities related to perfusionist listed below. As well as, sharing the responsibility of the service.

Principal responsibilities :

- Take care of the cardio-circulatory and cardio-pulmonary functions of the patient.
- Work with extracorporeal circulation devices during surgery or cardiac assistance to maintain physiological functions.
- Proceed with the start-up, monitoring, maintenance, transport, withdrawal and stopping of the circulatory devices.
- Program a cardio-stimulator or cardio-defibrillators, according to instructions.
- Follow-up of the cardiovascular pacemaker or cardio-defibrillator clientele in collaboration with the cardiologists.
